We recall his blessed passion and death,

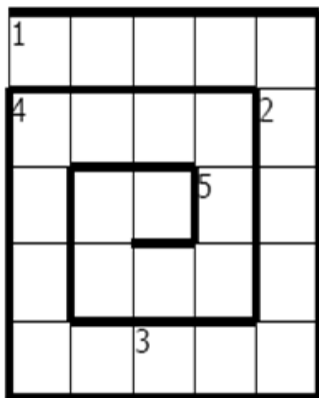

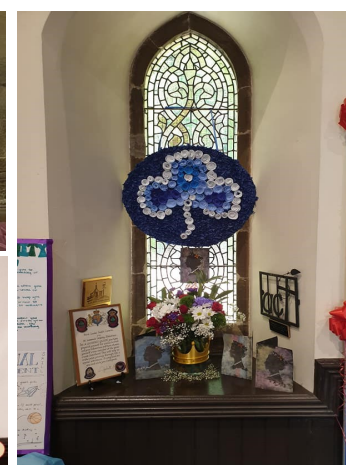
# Congratulations to Margaret
